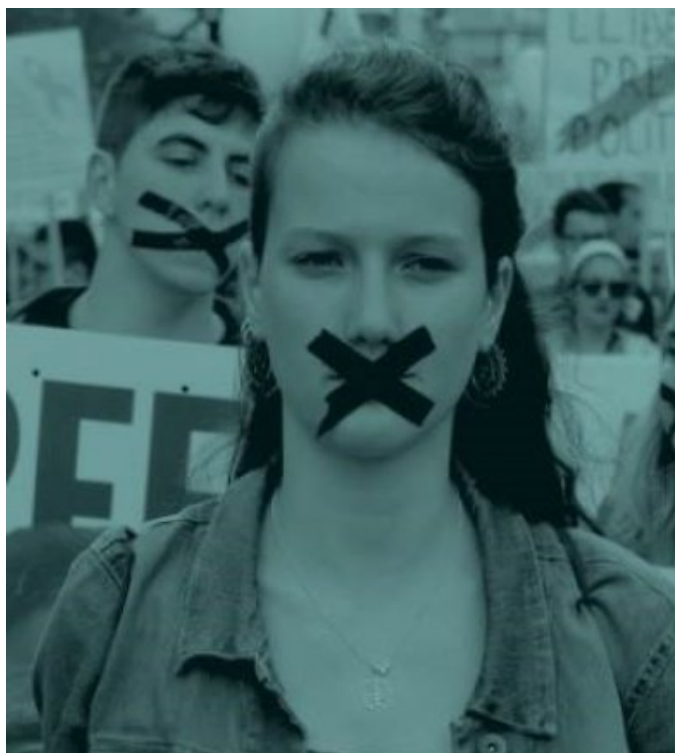
Exchange of views about fundamental rights in Spain
